# **ACC one of the fastest-growing in the nation, according to magazine**

**Austin Community College** has been named one of the 200 fastest-growing community colleges in the nation.

**ACC ranked 40th in the nation among public two-year colleges with 10,000 or more students, according to Community College Week. It is already the eighth largest community college in the nation.**

Additionally, ACC's spring semester is breaking a new enrollment record.

**The college's spring enrollment is 32,369 students, up 3.9 percent increase from spring 2007.**

"We will keep growing to meet the needs of the community," says Stephen B. Kinslow, ACC president and CEO. "Our mission is to close the education gaps in Central Texas and build a strong workforce for the future by getting more students into higher education and career training after high school."

**The school identified Round Rock as one of its fastest growing student populations. If Round Rock voters approve annexation into ACC's taxing district in May, the community college is planning to build its largest campus to date there.**

"Round Rock is clearly the fastest growing community in the ACC service area without a comprehensive community college presence," says Kinslow.
